

In this tutorial you will learn how to make a pretty bookmark



For all booklovers and friends of booklovers and creative enthusiasts, this project is going to help earn you some serious brownie points. It's easy and happy. In this tutorial you will learn how to make a pretty bookmark. If you are one of those who love reading as much as you love sewing, that's even better then.

What you will need for making this bookmark is – an 8×1.5 " piece of felt, a small colourful patch of your choice, a few pins, thread, marker, a measuring scale, and pinking shears. Trim the edges of the felt with your pinking shears, to get a zig zag edge, it will add a nice design element and prevent the fabric from fraying.

Draw a line at the centre of the fabric. Place the flower patch on top of the fabric and pin it to secure

Time to get stitching

Adjust your machine - turn the pattern selector to C and the stitch length selector to SS mode here.



Sew on the marked line, till you reach the patch. Use contrasting colours of thread so that the design stands out.

Lift up the needle to change the sewing pattern – turn the stitch pattern selector to A, and let the stitch length selector remain in the SS mode.

Continue stitching, from where you left off. Remove the pin and stitch till the centre of the patch. Lift the needle, and trim the extra thread, at both ends.



And viola! Your bookmark is ready.
We chose a flowery patch for this bookmark,
but feel free to pick your own patch or create it –
say for instance one big and one small square
placed quirkily. Or it could be a representation
of some work of fiction, or then a meaningful
patch for your philosophies, just about anything
works.
