Baby Girl Dress

In this tutorial you will learn how to make a dress for your baby girl.



If you are among the lucky ones to have a little girl who is the centre of your universe, we are sure you want to show your precious darling off to the world for all the happiness she brings to you! For all those of you who want to literally dress her up in love, this lesson is all about that. In this tutorial you will learn how to make a dress for your baby girl. So let's get this super-simple, and super-cute trendy dress started.

You will need the dress template, which you can download from our website ushasew.com. To make the dress you will need: a piece of fabric measuring 30 inches in length and the entire width of the fabric which is usually around 45 - 50 inches), safety pins, brooch to decorate, 2 x 42 inches lengths of 1 inch wide ribbon, threads, measuring tape, marker, and a pair of scissors.

Four-fold the fabric... like this...

Place the template over the folded piece of fabric ...From this point to this point marks the length of the garment. From the lower marked point to the end of the template is the lower hem allowance.



Similarly the space above the top marked line and the edge is the upper casing allowance. This is the arm-hole line and the side seam. The second line is the chest level including ease and the seam allowance.

Use beaded pins to pin the template to the fabric and using the marker trace its outline on the fabric like shown in the tutorial.

Cut along the marked lines. Take out the pins. Unfold the fabric and separate the two pieces. Now as you can see here -- fold the slanted armhole seam allowance with a double fold of $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Pin the fold into place. Repeat the folds on the other side. Similarly fold both edges on the other piece of fabric.

Now, it's time to stitch these folded edges. Select the A Stitch in the Pattern Selector Dial and set the stitch length to 2.5.

Sew the folded edges. Do remember to take the pins out as you sew.

These are the armholes of the dress. Sew all the four folded edges on both the fabric pieces. Next fold the top casing allowance by about half-inch; and again by one and half inch. Pin in place. Repeat the same on the other piece of fabric too.

Next sew the casing along the pinned edge of both the pieces.

We will begin by using straight stitches, with the Pattern selector at A and stitch length at two and a half.

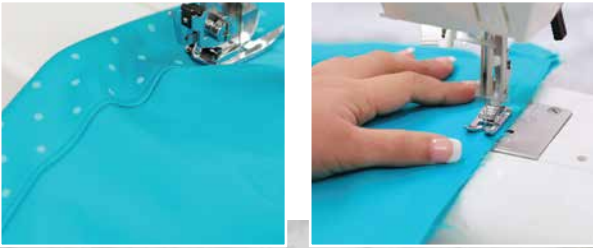
Remember to take out the pins as you sew along.

Next, we will sew the side seams of the two pieces together.

Make sure that the sides of both fabric pieces are aligned with right sides together.

The machine settings remain the same – Begin with a reverse stitch and sew both the pieces





together. Remember to end with a reverse stitch too.

Sew the other side too.

Fold the hem allowance by about half-inch; and again by one and half inches. And pin it. Now sew the hem line of the dress. Take out the pins as you sew.

We will sew zig-zag stitches, to give the edges a neat finish.

Turn the Pattern Selector to C and stitch length to 1.5.

Do the zig-zag stitch along the two side seams of the dress.

The sewing bit is now over – let's go on to complete this -- insert the ribbon through the tunnel casing created by the fold at the top here.

With the help of a safety pin pass the ribbon through the casing, as shown in the tutorial. Repeat on the other side using the other piece of ribbon.

Turn the dress right side out.

Pull the ribbons to get some gathers on the dress. Tie a knot with the ribbon ends, on both sides...make lovely bows like this. They are the straps that make the neck and arm-holes.

Pin the brooch on the dress.
